

1. Party Responsible for Data Processing

BrüggemannAlcohol Heilbronn GmbH, represented by Johannes Ingelfinger, Salzstr. 131, D-74076 Heilbronn, is responsible for collecting and processing the personal data on this website.

2. Collection and Saving of Personal Data

- a) Personal data are individual details regarding personal and objective circumstances of an identified or identifiable natural person, such as name, address, telephone number and IP address.
- b) The following personal data are collected during the use of our website:
name of pages retrieved, browser used, operating system in the domain requested, date and time of access, search engines used, name of files downloaded and your IP address.
Storing such data is only for internal system-related and statistical purposes.
- c) All personal data relating to use, in particular your IP address, will be deleted without undue delay once use has ceased. In individual cases the IP addresses may be held for a maximum of four weeks if this is necessary to ensure data security.

3. Consent and Revocation

- a) In addition, personal data will only be collected if you provide this voluntarily for example in connection with a query, in particular, when using the contact form and in so doing you give your consent in accordance with this Data Protection Statement.
- b) This consent may be revoked at any time with effect for the future without giving grounds and without observing any particular form. Revocation can also be made by email to the following address:

4. Use, Transfer and Deletion of Personal Data

- a) We will only use the personal data provided by you to answer your query or to enable a visit to our website or for technical administration of the website. The personal data will not be forwarded to third parties.
- b) On instruction from the competent bodies we are entitled in individual cases to provide information about personal data if this is required for purposes of prosecution, to avert risks by the police authorities of the federal states, to satisfy statutory requirements of the federal and state authorities to protect the constitution of the German intelligence service (*Bundesnachrichtendienst*) and the military counterintelligence service (*militärischer Abschirmdienst*) or to implement rights in intellectual property.

5. Security

We have undertaken a number of security measures in order to reasonably and adequately protect personal information. However, we cannot guarantee data security in transit to us by means of the Internet if communication is by e-mail.

6. Cookies
